

Spring Garden

January Prune fruit trees if weather permits
Plan Garden
Purchase seeds

February **February 1-7**
Start seedlings: Short season cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli.
February 15-20
Start seedlings: Tomatoes, peppers, eggplant if using hot caps to plant out in April.

March **March 1**
Prune: Blackberries, raspberries, grape vines.
Start seedlings: lettuce, peas, onions.
March 17
Plant: Peas, lettuce, strawberries, beets, spinach, chard.

April Fertilize berries
April 10
Plant Seedlings out: Cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli.
April 20
Plant: Tomatoes, peppers, eggplant under hot caps, radishes.
Start Seedlings: Cucumbers, squashes, melons.
Fertilize Strawberries with acid-loving plant fertilizer, cover with black or red plastic mulch.

Summer Garden

May **May 11**
Seedlings: Pumpkins, cucumbers, tomatoes, peppers
Seeds: beets. Bush beans, summer squash, corn, seed potatoes, cucumbers.
Seedlings: Onions, cucumbers, melons, winter squash, sweet potato starts, peppers, tomatoes if not using hot caps.

Fall Garden

June **June 1**
Start lettuce and pea seedlings.

June 20
Plant seeds: Corn, pole beans, carrots, peas, lettuce, spinach, long season cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower.
Fertilize onions.

July Harvest
Plant: Last day for corn planting.
Prune: Cut out old canes in ever bearing raspberries.

August Harvest
Share extra: Neighbor exchange, Bishops storehouse, local food pantry.

September Harvest
Plant: Garlic
Share extra: Neighbor exchange, Bishops storehouse, local food pantry.

October Harvest
Gather leaves.
Fertilizer, sulfur, ironite.
Cut Strawberries back to crown, dust with bug killer, mulch with hay or straw.
Pull out old plants, till in leaves and fertilizer.

General garden

1 cup ironite, 3 cups 16,16,8
fertilizer, 4 cups sulfur.
Covers 180 square feet.

Strawberries

1 part ironite, 1 part azelia
food, 1 part ammonium
sulphate. Sprinkle on like
salting a steak.

Corn

Fertilize one month after
planting with Ammonium
Sulfate and dust with seven.

Organic matter

peat moss, leaves, untreated
grass clippings, composted
yard waste.

Mycorrhizal Fungi

Increase plant's ability to
use fertilizer

Mulch

Mulch heat-loving plants
with black plastic mulch over
drip system: Melons, winter
squashes, pumpkins, cucum-
bers, tomatoes, peppers and
strawberries.
